Applications are now invited for the 2009-11 Rotary World Peace Fellowships offered by the Rotary Foundation and Western Australian Rotary Districts 9450, 9460 and 9470 for 2009-2011 to promote world peace and understanding.

### **Program Synopsis**

The [Rotary Centers for International Studies](#) program offers fellowships for master's degree study fields related to peace and conflict resolution. Beyond academic attainments, Rotary World Peace Fellows also gain practical skills in conflict resolution appropriate to their individual careers.

Up to 60 Rotary World Peace Fellows worldwide enroll each year in the six Rotary Centers based at leading universities in five countries: International Christian University, Japan; Universidad del Salvador, Argentina; University of Bradford, United Kingdom; University of Queensland, Australia; University of California-Berkeley, Calif., U.S.A., and Duke University and University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill, N.C.

Rotary World Peace Fellows are chosen on their potential to have a positive impact on world peace and conflict resolution during their future careers. The Fellowships are international in nature and Australian applicants cannot nominate the University of Queensland as their study centre.
