



Student contribution ranges for Commonwealth Supported Students in 2009

The table below gives the student contributions for units in 2009. These rates are linked with the maximum contribution levels as set by the Australian Government (for more information go to www.goingtouni.gov.au)

In 2009 The University of Notre Dame Australia will offer Commonwealth Supported Places in the areas of teaching, nursing and medicine. Not all units in a given course of study fall within the same contribution band. For example, if you are enrolled in a Bachelor of Education, you may undertake some units of study that are classified as 'education and some that are classified as 'humanities'. Therefore, your student contribution for the humanities units will be calculated against band 1, while for education units the national priorities band will be used. All fees shown in this document are "indicative" of a full time load in the specified discipline areas. Fees will vary based on the number and type of units chosen. Courses that have an overload component will attract higher annual fees.

Please note students are required to read the Information for Commonwealth Supported Students booklet in order to establish their correct Commonwealth commencement status.
